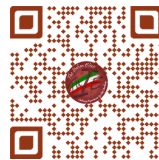

Here you can visit the splendid ageing rooms, which once were the coldest areas of the farmhouse, where natural humidity seeps in from the underground. These enchanting rooms still exist in the flatlands of Parma, near river Po, and they are the ideal environment for the curing of Culatello. Enjoy this unforgettable experience while you listen to this story made of time, passion and traditions.

Revel in a delicious Italian experience featuring local cuisine in the Osteria del Maiale Restaurant, inside the beautiful Antica Corte Pallavicina.
